The General Studies program is designed for students who are uncertain about a major degree program. Emphasis is placed on encouraging students to uncover their intellectual strengths and interests by taking courses in the Loyola Core plus introductory survey courses in academic disciplines to help them determine their scholastic path. **Students may remain in this program no longer than four semesters or 55 credit hours.** This requirement is absolute and may not be extended without explicit permission of the Dean. Space is provided below to record coursework and grades. When the Major is chosen, courses/grades already taken/earned will be applied to Major requirements or General Elective as appropriate. Courses used in the major cannot also be used to satisfy requirements for a minor: Non-major courses WILL be applied to minors as appropriate. Please note that students must achieve GPA of 2.0 in Major, Minor (if declared), and Loyola cumulative.
